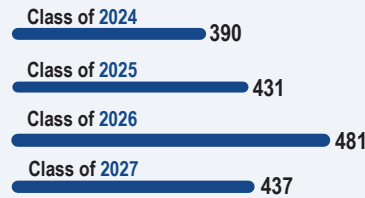
OVERVIEW

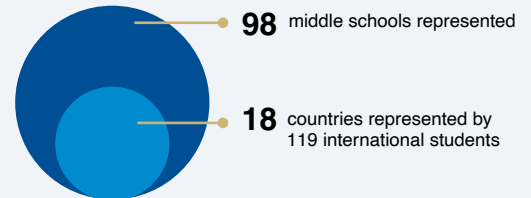

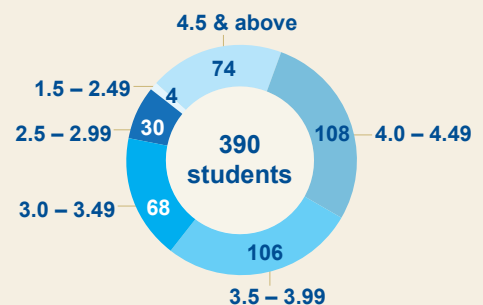

Anthony Rouzier enters his 5th year as the Head Coach at Santa Margarita Catholic (“SM”), and 7th year in the SM program. As Head Coach, Rouzier has the highest average California state ranking in SM’s history, at 13. In 2022, the team had their highest Trinity ranking since 2017, tying for 3rd. In 4 seasons, 39 players have earned athletic scholarships, 26 Players have gone on to play Division 1 Football, 19 to FBS (9 Power 5, 10 Group of 5), and 6 FCS. For 3 consecutive years SM has an All-American: Hero Kanu, ‘22, Collins Acheampong ‘23, Emmett Mosley ‘24. There has been a 100% graduation rate, 99% College rate.

Prior to Rouzier’s time as the Head Coach, he was the Interim Head Coach in 2020, Defensive Coordinator 2020 and Linebacker Coach in 2018 and 2019.

Prior to his time at Santa Margarita, Rouzier the Hamburg Huskies of the German Football League, where he was the interim Head Coach and Defensive Coordinator in 2017. For the end of the season’s success, Rouzier was promoted and accepted the Head Coaching position.

Rouzier was also the Defensive Coordinator for the U17 Hamburg State All-Star team. Rouzier also worked with Premier Players International, a recruiting service that has helped over 150 European prospects earn Division 1 college scholarships.

Prior to Germany, Rouzier was a graduate assistant at his Alma Mater, the University of Massachusetts. He worked with the Defensive Backs in 2015 and the Linebackers in 2016.

Rouzier coached the Outside Linebackers at Winston Salem State University in the spring of 2015. In 2014, Rouzier coached at Amherst Regional High School where he started as the Linebacker’s coach and was promoted to Defensive Coordinator mid-season.

Rouzier played at UConn in 2005, he was the first walk-on true freshman to start in the Division

era of the school. He then transferred to UMass as a scholarship athlete, and was a part of two Conference Championships, and the second-place team in FCS in 2006, losing to App State.

He earned All-Academic All-Conference honors in 2007 & 2008.

Rouzier married his wife Elwira in 2018, whom he met while coaching in Germany. They have 2 children, Junior (4), and Victoria (1). He graduated with a Bachelor’s Degree in Journalism from UMass, and earned a Juris Doctorate and Masters of Business Administration in FIU’s Dual-Degree program.

He was awarded the distinguished Community Service Fellowship Award at FIU’s College of Law. He is the co-creator of a children’s book, Henry Gets Moving, and a non-profit that promotes health and wellness.

HIGHLIGHTS OF LAST WEEK'S GAME - @ CENTENNIAL (CORONA)

Santa Margarita Catholic rebounded from a distressful season-opening loss at Mission Viejo to stun perennial power Centennial in Corona, 31-15. The Eagles were on the road for the second-straight week against a nationally-ranked opponent and rose to the occasion as they bolted to a 31-0 lead in the early fourth quarter. The game, televised by Bally Sports SoCal, displayed the talent SMC possesses to the greater Southern California audience. The Huskies had come into the contest ranked No. 16 in the nation and No. 3 in California by MaxPreps.com. The victory is most certainly the “signature win” in Head Coach Anthony Rouzier’s tenure at SMC thus far. Many players on offense and defense provided highlights and statistics in the triumph.

Eagle’s Highlights

- SMC tallied 333 yards of total offense, including 226 through the air from the arm of John Gazzaniga. Underclassmen Jaion Smith and Hayes Cloutier combined to amass 88 yards on the ground.
- Junior sensation Trent Mosley had another superb game with 11 receptions for 207 yards (18.8 average) and two scores. He also added a rushing touchdown. The scoring receptions were 51 and 67 yards in length.
- The defense played rugged and spirited as they coaxed Centennial into four turnovers. Junior linebacker Dash Fifita was a cyclone on the field with his 14 total tackles. Leki Holani was equally as deliberate with 11 total tackles (4 tackles for loss) and one sack.
- J.J. Hanne registered a sack while Luke Anderson notched his first career interception as did freshman Ca’ron “Prime” Williams. For the entirety of the contest, Anderson and fellow defensive back Logan Hirou delivered resounding hits and tackles to the opposition.
- Newcomers Ivrick Carrigan and Jayden Crowder each recovered fumbles in key situations, coming from strips by Leki Holani and Joseph Terry.
- Kicker Ryan Gass calmly booted a 42-yard field goal in the first half. This was the longest of his prep career and first over 40-yards in distance. The senior is now 5-of-6 on field goal tries in his career (83.3%).
- The Eagle’s win over the Huskies avenged last season’s 35-21 setback at Saddleback College and evened the all-time match-up at one win each.

Santa Margarita Catholic made the three-hour / 185-mile trek up to Bakersfield to take on strong Liberty club. The Patriots were the defending CIF-State Division 1-AA champions. After the first quarter of play, the game looked as if it would be a classic shootout as both schools displayed little defensive success. Tied at 14-14, the Eagles defense rose to play its best three quarters of ball in some time. With the offense doing well, SMC rolled to a 34-14 victory. Liberty opened the game with a flurry of activity, scoring two touchdowns during a 0:54 second stretch, but soon learned that pace was not sustainable.

SMC scored the last 27 points in the game thanks to the dominant offensive game enjoyed by Trent Mosley. The then talented sophomore took over the game and made a case for himself as the most dynamic playmaker in Southern California prep football. Lining up all over the field, Mosley rushed for two scores and caught two touchdown passes in the resounding win. Mosley's touchdown passes were 83 and 10 yards in length, both from Hunter Melton. He totaled 227 yards of offense as the Eagles gained 471 as a team.

Another offensive weapon that is difficult for opponents to control, Sean Embree, had a beautiful 46-yard touchdown catch from Melton early in the game. Melton finished 17-of-25 (68.0%) passing for 316 yards and three touchdowns. Mosley tallied 187 receiving yards on nine catches (20.8 average) and on the ground mustered three carries for 40 yards (13.3 average). Embree had six catches for 124 yards (20.7 average). All of those statistical numbers for the three players are new career highs.

Defensively, Logan Hirou snagged one interception to give him three for the season. LeVar Talley contributed two tackles for loss and one sack. He and teammate Gage Burnett led the team with eight tackles.

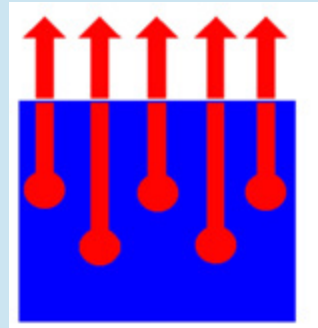
