LAST GAME VS. INGLEWOOD -- CIF-SS DIVISION 1 FIRST ROUND

In the First Round of the CIF-Southern Section Division 1 playoff, Santa Margarita Catholic was a rude host as it steamrolled previously undefeated Inglewood, 59-26. The Eagle's offense, defense and special teams were in high gear as the Sentinels had no answer for the speed, athleticism and depth of Coach Steve Fifita's squad. As healthy as the club has been all season, many stepped up to add their name to the score sheet and highlight reel. SMC enters Friday's challenge with vigor, especially knowing they can stand with the once vaunted Braves.

Individual Highlights:

- John Gazzaniga completed 18-of-25 passes (70.8%) for 343 yards and three touchdowns and rushed for one score.
 At one point he completed 10 passes in succession in the first half. The senior quarterback now has 13 touchdown passes on the season
- All three touchdowns were to sophomore receiver Jack Junker and all in the first half. At halftime, Junker had 157
 receiving yards, all on the three touchdown catches (38.3 average). He finished with a career-high of 172 yards on
 five receptions. Junker's average per reception of 34.4 would have been much higher if not for one of his five catches
 netting near zero yardage
- Tight end Fisher Melton had the best game of his prep career. The senior registered five catches for 50 yards (10.0 average)
- James Johnson came off the bench to throw a 30-yard touchdown pass to sophomore tight end Luke Gazzaniga. The senior quarterback now has eight touchdown passes this season
- Trent Mosley had two rushing attempts for 20 yards (10.0 average) and scored twice. He also contributed four receptions for 85 yards (21.3 average)
- Jaion "Duce" Smith scored his fourth rushing touchdown of the season and has now gained 594 yards, adding to his
 freshman record
- Linebacker Leki Holani notched a safety early in the first quarter to give SMC a 2-0 advantage. He also collected three tackles for loss and 1 1/2 sacks. His mate, Ivrick Carrigan, had 1 1/2 sacks as well. Jason Perez registered one sack.
- J.J. Hanne registered one sack and had a huge pass deflection
- Tight end Luke Gazzaniga collected his second pass reception of the season. It was his first-ever touchdown scored at the prep level

- Ryan Gass was a perfect 7-for-7 on PAT conversions
- For the second time this season, two unlikely defensive / special teams players got into the offensive column. A snap on one of the PAT conversion attempts was mishandled and turned into 2-points for the Eagles. Holder Dash Fifita took the ball and calmly rolled-out to his right and found J.J. Hanne all alone in the end zone for the successful try
- As a team, SMC amassed 485 yards of total offense

Points Perspective and More:

- The win ended a school record six-consecutive CIF Playoff losses. The last SMC win was in 2016 at Junipero Serra (Gardena), 27-14
- The 59 points cored are the most by SMC since a 2022 nonleague home game against Mullen (Denver) -- a 63-6 triumph. That same season, the Eagle's pinned 56 points on Servite in a 56-14 romp
- The 59 points are the most-ever scored by SMC in a postseason playoff game. This bested the previous high of 56 in a First Round loss at Murrieta Valley in 2017 (Lost 59-56)
- The previous school record for point sin a postseason playoff victory was in the 1997 CIF-SS Division V championship game versus Tustin -- 55-42 win by the Eagles
- SMC is 5-5 all-time in rematches with a same opponent in the same season (0-1 vs. St. John Bosco)
