HIGHLIGHTS OF LAST WEEK'S GAME - LIBERTY (BAKERSFIELD)

Game time temperature still hovered around the 100-degree mark as Santa Margarita Catholic (SMC) kicked off to visiting Liberty (Bakersfield) on “Senior Night.” The Patriots come from the lower Central Valley where these triple-digit readings are routine. However, it was the Eagles that brought the sizzle and never let Liberty gather a gasp of success as they rolled, 42-3.

For the third-straight week, Steve Fifita’s defense was intense and inspired. This season, the squad has demonstrated speed and athleticism that the program has not seen in the past several years. Stout and rigged play limited the Patriots to short gains, tightly defended passes and quarterback hurries that led to mistakes. J.J. Hanne and Tonga Uhila made themselves very friendly in the backfield. Logan Hirou and Luke Anderson introduced themselves as they snagged interceptions.

The big story of the evening, though, was the quarterback play of James Johnson. The game started with “J.J.” alternating each series with John Gazzaniga. Quickly, the senior caught fire, showed poise, and threw some remarkably accurate passes to a talented stable of receivers. When he was done, he had five touchdowns passing to three receivers. Jack Junker and Trent Mosley each snared two and tight end Fisher Melton one.
